Subject- African-American history

Lesson Topic: Colonial Slavery in the North

Standard: Colonial Slavery in the North

Introduction: Students will write a 1 page expository essay on whether current Blacks should receive financial compensation for Slavery

Focus Lesson or Learning Objective: Colonial Slavery in the North

Essential Question: Why is it important to learn about Slavery in the North?

Modeling: Direct Instruction on Colonial Slavery in the North

Guided Practice or Independent Study: Students will watch the presentation on "Traces of the Trade: a Story from the Deep North"/2 page summary is required from the presentation

Closing: Teacher will highlight specific parts of the movie for open discussion through critical thinking
